Issues/Status:	The lawsuit alleges that CalPERS violated the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act and the California Public Records Act (PRA) by holding the Board's August 17, 2020 meeting – a CEO briefing on performance, employment, and personnel issues – in closed session, and by refusing to disclose the transcript of that meeting in response to a PRA request. The lawsuit also alleges that CalPERS violated the PRA by refusing to produce
	records in response to a PRA requesting documents regarding allegedly overvalued private assets.
