

Pension & Health Benefits Committee

Meeting Summary

June 16, 2021

The Pension & Health Benefits Committee (PHBC) met on June 15, 2021.

The Committee received reports on the following topics:

• The Committee received preliminary 2022 plan rates for Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) and Preferred Provider Organization (PPO).

The Chair directed staff to:

- Have Dr. Logan speak about Post-COVID conditions including Long COVID in a future update to the Board.
- Continue monitoring aducanumab, the new Alzheimer's drug approved by the FDA to shed more light on efficacy, as well as cost-effectiveness, and report back.
- Review plans to make sure they're giving the right information to members, whether networks are adequate, and if plans are sending people out of network when they shouldn't be.

At this time, I would like to share some highlights of what to expect at the September PHBC meeting:

- Final HMO and PPO health plan rates will be approved at the July Board of Administration Offsite.
- The Committee will review proposed regulation for the definition of Limited Duration.

The next meeting of the PHBC is scheduled for September 14, 2021, in Sacramento, California.
