Agenda Item 3 - Executive Report(s)

Anthony Suine, Deputy Executive Officer, Customer Services and Support (CSS), highlighted the following items: steady 2021 first quarter retirement trends compared to last year; continued over 15,000 virtual counseling appointments since March as well as outreach to members for ongoing meeting preference; released new enhancements at our third virtual CalPERS Benefit Education Event, including an interactive information center, and resource center, and also offered 20 classes attended by almost 5,000 members with high satisfaction ratings; the beginning of blended in-person and virtual events will kick off next year; a new online functionality allowing members to calculate the cost of a service credit purchase used by 36 percent of requests in the first four months, and elect from their self-service account, used by 45 percent of service credit purchases in the first month; and shared a story about how the team works to assist public servants in times of tragedy.

Don Moulds, Chief Health Director, Health Policy & Benefits Branch (HPBB), shared that work by CalPERS and Dr. Logan while she was employed by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) was recently recognized in a study published by Journal of the American Medical Association. The work looked at efforts by CalPERS and DHCS that decreased elective cesarian section rates. He also shared the launch of the CalPERS Health Care Training Academy's first cohort and noted that it will start this summer. He also provided updates on increased Long-Term Care communications with members, and pandemic related spending trends including pharmacy trends.
