## Subject: Actuarial Valuation Report for the 1959 Survivor Benefit Program

Dear Governor Newsom,

The CalPERS Board of Administration (CalPERS) has accepted the June 30, 2021 Actuarial Valuation of the 1959 Survivor Benefit Program.

In the report, the actuarially determined required employer premium for the State 5<sup>th</sup> Level for fiscal year 2022-23 is **\$5.60** per covered member, per month. This reflects a decrease from the \$5.85 required employer premium from the previous year. The June 30, 2021 funded status of the State 5<sup>th</sup> Level pool on a market value basis is 88.2%. This compares with 74.2% for the previous fiscal year.

The actuarially determined required employer premium for the School 5<sup>th</sup> Level for fiscal year 2022-23 is **\$0.00**. This reflects no change from the \$0.00 required employer premium from the previous fiscal year. The June 30, 2021 funded status of the School 5<sup>th</sup> Level pool on a market value basis is 744.2%. This compares with 620.7% for the previous fiscal year.

The board is pleased to file the 2021 report for the 1959 Survivor Benefit Program with the Governor and the Legislature.
