PROCEEDINGS 1 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Good morning, everyone. 2 We'd like to call the Performance, Compensation and Talent 3 Management Committee to order. 4 The first order of business in open session will 5 be to call the roll. 6 COMMITTEE SECRETARY: Rob Feckner? 7 8 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Good morning. COMMITTEE SECRETARY: Eraina Ortega? 9 VICE CHAIRPERSON ORTEGA: 10 Here COMMITTEE SECRETARY: Lisa Middleton? 11 COMMITTEE MEMBER MIDDLETON: Present 12 COMMITTEE SECRETARY: David Miller? 13 COMMITTEE MEMBER MILLER: Here. 14 COMMITTEE SECRETARY: Jose Luis Pacheco? 15 16 COMMITTEE MEMBER PACHECO: Present. COMMITTEE SECRETARY: 17 Theresa Taylor? COMMITTEE MEMBER TAYLOR: Here. 18 COMMITTEE SECRETARY: Mullissa Willette? 19 20 COMMITTEE MEMBER WILLETTE: Here. COMMITTEE SECRETARY: Thank you. 21 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Thank you. We're now going 2.2 23 to go into closed session to discuss items 1 through 4 on the closed session agenda, then we will be having --24 25 partaking in our annual ice cream social as well as lunch.

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So I would anticipate open session not beginning before 1 1:30. So keep watching the monitors, but I would assume 2 somewhere around 1:30 we'll be in open session. 3 So if we could please clear the room other than 4 those that should be here, we will start closed session as 5 soon as you all are gone. 6 7 (Off record: 10:16 a.m.) (Thereupon the meeting recessed 8 Into closed session.) 9 (Thereupon the meeting reconvened 10 open session.) 11 (On record: 3:15 p.m.) 12 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: All right. We're going to 13 call the Performance Compensation open session back in to 14 session, please. We've already done items 1 and 2. 15 16 First off, I want to say, those of you that have been waiting, sorry for the delay. This is a new process 17 that we undertook and it took us some time to get through 18 19 it, but it's a much more aligned process, I do believe. So thank you for your patience. 20 Item 3, Executive report, Mr. Hoffner. 21 CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER HOFFNER: Thank you, Mr. 2.2 23 Chair. Doug Hoffner, CalPERS team member. Our next regularly schedule committee is not 24 25 until February of 2023. But prior to that in November of

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this year, your compensation consultants Global Governance 1 Advisors will be here to conduct workshop regarding the 2 Board's Compensation Policy for executive and investment 3 management positions. This is at the request of the 4 5 Committee and is something we've been working towards for some time. With that Chair, that answers -- or that 6 7 concludes my report. 8 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Thank you. 9 Item 4, action consent items. What's the pleasure of the Committee? 10 COMMITTEE MEMBER TAYLOR: Move approval 11 COMMITTEE MEMBER PACHECO: I'll second it. 12 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: It's been moved by Taylor, 13 seconded by Pacheco. 14 Any discussion on the motion? 15 16 All in favor say aye? 17 (Ayes.) CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Opposed, no? 18 Motion carries. 19 20 Item 5, information consent items. Having no requests to move anything, it takes us to agenda Item 6, 21 summary of committee direction. Mr. Hoffner, did you 2.2 catch it all? 23 CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER HOFFNER: I did. 24 25 CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: Very good.

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So seeing none, it brings us to 6B, Public Comment. I have one request to speak from the public, Mr. Jelincic.

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Please identify yourself for the record and the clock will start when you do.

MR. JELINCIC: J.J. Jelincic. And I noticed you didn't report out anything.

CHAIRPERSON FECKNER: No, that will be tomorrow.

MR. JELINCIC: Okay. Last year is a baked cake. 9 10 However, going forward change can happen. I know that the issue of incentive comp criteria is coming back to this 11 Committee. For most employees, we do not know what their 12 bonuses are based on. In terms of the investment 13 performance measurement, it's a shame that the Board does 14 15 not use a benchmark that can be independently verified. 16 When the Board uses a customized index and then gives staff the authority to change the elements of that 17 benchmark, an independent observation and comparison dies. 18 When the Board authorizes the staff to change the 19 20 weighting of private assets in the benchmark, both control and independent verification are lost. 21

I have no idea if this changeability to the benchmark added to the improved excess returns in the last few years that Wilshire pointed out. There is no way to know and that is the problem.
