



Certificated School Members Update

Reporting Certificated School Members

Government (Gov.) Code section 20962.1

Contracted school employers are responsible for accurately reporting certificated school members. Pursuant to Gov. Code section 20962, full-time service – basis of employment is defined as:

(1) One academic year of service for persons employed on an academic year basis by the University of California, the California State University system, or school employees who are certificated school members, under terms and conditions prescribed by the CalPERS board.



Certificated School Members

One year of service credit per academic year

One year of service credit per fiscal year

Regardless of hours worked



myCalPERS Enhancements

Certificated School Members

- Enrollment Indicator on appointment detail screen
- Certificated Members with Less than a Full Year of Service Credit Report (Cognos) – March 2021
- XML enrollment requirement June 2021



New Reporting Process

Begins 2022/2023 fiscal year:

- 1. Employer enrolls certificated members into myCalPERS
- 2. CalPERS runs a query of certificated members
 - Sends letter to the district if certificated member has not attained 1 year of service credit
- Employer corrects payroll to ensure member receives fullservice credit

- CalPERS will reach out for list of impacted members
- Employers can start updating appointments in myCalPERS now

Retired Annuitant COVID-19 Exemption Appointments

COVID-19 Exemption Appointments

Hours worked not counted toward 960-hour limit

Suspension of:

- 180-day wait period
- Bona fide separation

Must contact CalHR at CAstateofemergency@calhr.ca.gov



Interim/Vacant Positions Governor's Executive Order N-84-20

Limitation of being appointed once lifted

Requirements not lifted by governor's executive order

- Must be appointed by agency's governing body (County Office of Education (COE))
- During recruitment



Retirees in Permanent Positions

COVID-19 related turnovers and vacancies

Retirees assisting with ensuring adequate staffing

Retirees must vacate position once order is lifted

Rehired Annuitant Social Security Coverage

Retirement System Ineligibles

Ineligible for retirement system due to personal disqualification

• E.g., hours worked, receiving a pension from the same retirement system

Must be ineligible for retirement system membership on the date the employee first occupied the position

• If an employee optionally declines membership, they are not retirement system ineligible

Ineligibles may be covered by Section 218 Agreement

Rehired annuitants are a type of retirement system ineligible

Rehired Annuitant

A rehired annuitant is a retiree of a state, political subdivision, or instrumentality who:

- Participated in a retirement system
- Is rehired by their former employer or another employer that participates in the same retirement system the individual's pension is coming from
- Is either receiving a retirement benefit from the retirement system or has reached retirement age under the retirement system

School District Social Security Coverage

Modification 315

- Covers all school districts in California
- Divided vote
- Covers classified positions under CalPERS
- Does not contain language to cover retirement system ineligibles

Some school districts have entered into additional modification agreements to provide coverage for retirement system ineligibles

Additional Information About Coverage

Rehired annuitants may still be covered under Social Security if:

- Employee does not meet the definition of Social Security's "rehired annuitant"
- Employer entered into a modification agreement to cover retirement system ineligibles (either of CalPERS/CalSTRS or both)

Note: Anyone hired or rehired after April 1, 1986, is covered mandatorily for Medicare

Rehired Annuitant Information Needed

Which school district are they being rehired into?

What position will they be occupying?

What retirement benefits are offered to someone in this position who is not a rehired annuitant?

Which system are they receiving their annuity from?

Sample Inquiry: Example 1

COE is hiring an annuitant who is:

- Receiving a CalPERS pension
- Hired into a position covered under CalPERS

School District <u>does not</u> have any additional modification to provide coverage to retirement system ineligibles

Guidance: The rehired annuitant is:

- Not covered under a Section 218 Agreement and is not subject to Mandatory Social Security
- Subject to Medicare



Sample Inquiry: Example 2

COE is hiring an annuitant who is:

- Receiving a CalPERS pension
- Hired into a position covered under CalPERS

School District <u>has</u> a modification to provide coverage to retirement system ineligibles

Guidance: The rehired annuitant is:

 Covered for Social Security and Medicare under the school district's Section 218 Agreement

Request employee count January-February for invoices issued in late March

Invoices sent to County Offices of Education for their respective school districts

Include the school districts' CIDs for easy identification

School District AIR

About the AIR


All school districts will be issued an AIR in myCalPERS

Questions about tax withholding for both CalPERS and CalSTRS members


Request for total number of employees at each school district




