SUBJECT: 1959 Survivor Employer Contribution for Fiscal Year 2009-2010

On May 12, 2009, the CalPERS Board of Administration approved the State 5<sup>th</sup> Level pool employer rates for the 1959 Survivor Pre-retirement Death Benefit. This benefit pays a monthly amount to the survivor(s) of a member who dies while actively working for a state agency that does not participate in the Federal Social Security program. The employer contribution rate will decrease from \$5.20 for the current fiscal year to \$4.75 per member, per month for fiscal year 2009-2010.

In addition, for fiscal year 2009-2010, there will be a decrease to the employee contribution rate, to \$4.75 per member per month. The change in the employee contribution rate is in accordance with Section 21581 of the California Public Employees' Retirement Law which states that when the total required premium goes above \$4.00 per member, per month, the employer and employee shall split the total cost evenly.

Currently the funded ratio of the State 5<sup>th</sup> Level pool on a market value basis is 90.4%. The actual cost of the 1959 Survivor benefit to the employer and employee will vary from year to year due to investment returns and mortality gains and losses experienced by the pool.

The purpose of this transmittal is informational only; the State Controller's Office will be collecting the required premiums from state agencies at a later date.
