## SUBJECT: NEW ON-LINE ADDRESS CHANGE SERVICE AVAILABLE

The California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS) is pleased to announce our newest on-line self-service tool for members – Change Your Address. CalPERS' active, inactive, and retired members, as well as almost anyone receiving a CalPERS' benefit allowance, can now change their mailing address and phone information using the CalPERS web site.

Currently, the most common reason members call our Customer Call Center is to notify CalPERS of an address change. This new on-line service will provide another avenue for members to keep their mailing address information current. They can view their address and phone information currently in our computer systems and make any updates as needed. Since this tool accesses personal member data, users must have a Personal Identification Number (PIN) to use it. If they do not have a PIN, they can register to receive one on CalPERS On-Line.

In addition, employers that are using the Automated Communications Exchange System (ACES) can view a member address through the Participant Inquiry function. For more information or to sign up for ACES, please visit ACES at www.calpers.ca.gov/aces.
