

Proposals Align with Strategic Goal





OOS Basic PPO Option

- Background
 - 11% of Basic PPO members live OOS
 - These members largely only have PERS Platinum available
- Goal
 - Explore lower-cost health plan option for Basic members residing outside California without impacting in-state PPO premiums



OOS Basic PPO Options

Option 1

- Expand PERS Gold to OOS members
- Maintain current benefit design
- In-state PPO premiums would increase 2-3%

Option 2

- Create new OOS PERS Gold plan
- Significantly increase member deductible, maximum copays, and coinsurance
- Minimal to no impact to in-state PPO premiums

Option 3 (recommended)

- Do not add OOS PERS Gold Plan for 2026
- No impact to in-state premiums

Current VBID Design for PERS Gold Members

Reduced Inpatient Deductible

- Preventive Screening
- Flu Shot
- Non-Smoking Certification
- Second Opinion
- Care Management participation

Reduced Copayment

 \$10 copay applies to matched primary care office visits and behavioral health visits



Inpatient Maternity Waiver

 Waived hospital coinsurance for maternity care if member engages in Maternity Program





Goals and Considerations for 2026



Align VBID incentives to support the Quality Alignment Measure Set

Retain high-impact elements of current VBID

- Engagement in care management
- Use of preventive care services

Maintain relative neutrality in total cost of care and premium

2026 VBID Proposal for PERS Gold Members

- Retain PCP \$10 copay incentive
- Enhance Maternity Program with participation requirements
- 5 credits total, from the choices below, needed to participate.

Engagement

- Participation in Included Health's Care/Case Management
- Expert Medical Opinion obtained for any elective surgery
- Diabetes Prevention Program participation

Mental Health/Well-being

- Depression screening
- Anxiety screening

Prevention

- Cancer screening (breast, cervical, colorectal, lung)
- Metabolic health (hypertension, diabetes or lipid monitoring or screening)
- Flu vaccine and other adult immunizations

^{*}Combined maximum of 5 credits of \$100 each for a total credit of \$500 applied to the inpatient deductible
