SUBJECT: REINSTATEMENT OF HEALTH BENEFITS COVERAGE FOR STATE **EMPLOYEES RETURNING FROM MILITARY LEAVE** 

As more state employees are returning to work from extended military leave, this circular letter is a reminder that reinstatement of health benefits coverage for employees is to resume immediately.

- The health coverage for a member who has returned from Military Leave is to resume immediately upon their return to work.
- To make the health coverage effective upon the member's return to work, employers must submit form 674, Payroll Adjustment Notice, to the California State Controller's Office with specific information to resume premium payment(s) early.
- Enclosed is a copy of form 674. You may also obtain a copy of this form from the Department of General services Web site at www.dgs.ca.gov
